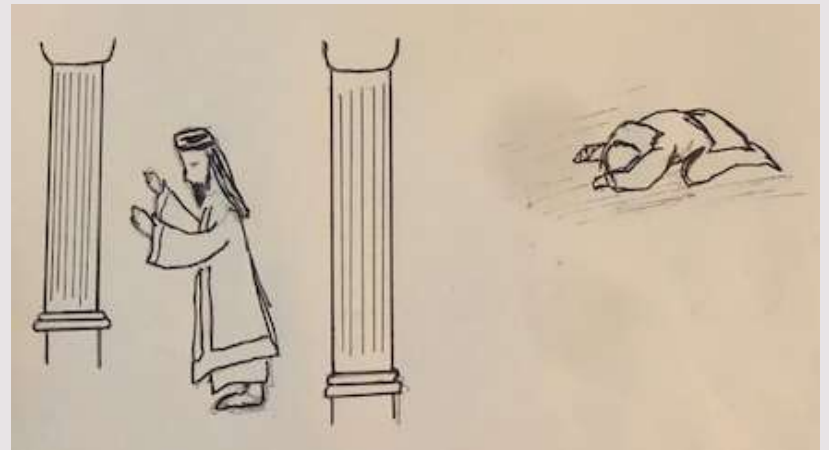
A great lifestyle
